## Small bookstores step to fill the void as large chains falter

Technology that has dramatically changed the way consumers buy, read and keep books has had an unexpected consequence.

The rise of online bookstores and digital-reading devices such as Kindles and iPads is indirectly fostering a resurgence of independent bookstores.

The digital books that can be quickly downloaded on a growing number of e-readers and carried anywhere have hastened the demise of the book-superstore chains and created room once again for independents.


Indie bookstores have become some of the leading repositories for old-fashioned paper books and havens for traditional-book lovers who crave the tactile sensation of holding a book and leafing through paper pages.

The American Booksellers Association reports an increase in membership this year for the first time in more than a decade.

"I like the smell of the paper and ink," said John Hardin of Phoenix, who was browsing the shelves recently at Bards Books, an independent bookstore in the Phoenix area.

As communication becomes less personal via texting and Facebook, independent bookstores are becoming increasingly important "third places," where people can gather and physically connect outside offices and homes. They are venues for poetry readings, lectures, classes and community meetings.

"The Internet has the best selection and prices, but we offer human interaction," said Bob Oldfather, chief executive of Bookmans, a Phoenix-area bookstore. "There are a

lot of people who are still willing to pay for that."

Some stores are even finding success selling e-books to those who prefer to patronize the website of a local bookstore rather than one of a national retailer such as Amazon. com.

Seizing opportunity

"We sense an opportunity, particularly since Borders is closing," said Gayle Shanks, who owns Changing Hands Bookstore in Tempe, Ariz.

Borders Group Inc. closed many stores after filing for bankruptcy in February. It is liquidating the remaining stores this summer.

Online bookstores, such as Amazon, that offer deep discounts, have taken a toll on sales of hardcover best-sellers at Changing Hands, but the business has responded by increasing its selection of children's books and adding games, toys and back-to-school supplies to compensate for the sales decline in best-sellers.

Still, Shanks doesn't relish Borders' demise.

"Anytime there is one

less bookstore, it's a loss for the entire community," she said.

#### Fresh momentum

Meg Smith, director of membership and marketing at the American Booksellers Association in Tarrytown, N.Y., said membership in the trade association for independent bookstores is up 7 percent this year.

That's after flat growth for the past two years and steady declines in membership for more than a decade before that.

She also said enrollment in the ABA classes on opening and running an independent bookstore is up markedly.

"There's been a steady improvement that's gaining momentum," Smith said. "People still aspire to own a bookstore."

Smith partially attributed the resurgence to the decline of the chains and to growing support among consumers for independent retailers.

"A growing number of people would rather support a locally owned business instead of a national chain," she said.
